Submission guidelines

Nepalese Translation is a peer-reviewed journal of Society of Translators Nepal. The Journal requires contributors to follow the guidelines given below to submit their manuscripts:

1. The main title; the name of the author(s); author affiliations and e-mail address(es).
2. Title : Maximum 12 words
3. Abstract: Maximum 150 words (italics)
4. Keywords: Maximum 5 words/phrases
5. Maximum number of words: 5000
6. Minimum number of words: 3000
7. Page size : 18 cm × 24 cm
8. Orientation: Portrait
9. Margins: 1.5 cm in all sides
10. Line spacing: Double
11. Paragraph spacing: 6 point before and 0 point after; but no paragraph space between the lines in the same example (including gloss, and free translation). Please note that each example will be considered as a paragraph.
12. Footnotes: Must be numbered following the APA style.
13. Fonts: Times New Roman (11 point) for description
14. Data from other than English need to be transcribed in International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA) Unicode (10 point) (for spoken data) and transliterated into Roman 10 point (for written data).
15. References in the text and Reference section: American Psychological Association (APA, 6th Edition)
16. Headings and subheadings need to be numbered (in decimal like 1, 1.1, 1.2, 1.2.1 etc.) and example data must be numbered (in brackets such as (1), (2), (3)).
17. If other scripts are necessary (on orthography, dictionary, etc.), please use the fonts compatible with Unicode.
18. Please use Arabic numerals to number tables and figures consecutively. Provide each table with a caption above it while the figure caption should appear below the figure.
19. Please submit both DOC/DOCX and PDF files.

We encourage authors to provide critical literature reviews utilizing the most recent publications in the relevant field for their theoretical and conceptual backdrop. More importantly, works must be undertaken in an ethical manner. If there are any ethical concerns on a paper, whether published or in review, the author(s) should contact the editor(s) in the first instance.
